

How many of the courses included in your curriculum did you attend regularly?








Over time comparison










Over time comparison



Corso inutilmente teorico estremamente stressante e improduttivo

I feel the Master's program at Bocconi needs to be improved in significant ways in order to once again be considered a top Master's in Finance program.

I realised that I enrolled in the MSc Finance thinking it would be very quantitative. While it is well-rounded and more quantitative than many other MSc Finance, I think I would enroll in a MSc in Financial Engineering, which Bocconi sadly does not have.

Il corso di Finanza e' un corso di altissima specializzazione, completo come pochi altri in Europa e nel mondo. Purtroppo esistono corsi meno impegnativi piu' riconosciuti a livello curricolare.

Il corso e' inutilmente pesante e teorico, rispetto a cio' che richiede il mondo del lavoro e cio' che offrono altre universita' europee, con placement decisamente migliori. Molti colleghi riscontrano che il career service e' pressoche' inutile

Limitati sbocchi professionali

Other universities abroad offer greater assistance in placement at top institutions with an overall less study load.

Ottimo dal punto di vista accademico, disastroso nel supporto al placement che invece altri atenei concorrenti offrono. Il placement rimane comunque buono ma piu' per la qualita' degli studenti e dell'ampio network di alumni, non per il supporto ricevuto.

Ritengo la struttura del corso e la modalita' di studio e apprendimento troppo similare a quella della triennale. Il valore aggiunto quando si va al lavoro e' poco, soprattutto se paragonato ad altre universita' estere.

The curriculum during the first year was too broad, several courses had no added value for my current career path. Would be more sensible to be able to specialize earlier or simply have specialized 1-year master programs.


The placement of the MSc in Finance program is too weak compared to the other top European Universities and the program is too focused on academics

Too many badly delivered courses involving theoretical mathematics, such as Quantitative Finance I, Econometrics I and II and Theory of Finance. These courses hurt my GPA and I will never use their contents in real life.






